- The contribution of libraries in the promotion of culture (e.g. regional principle vs. national principle).

- New forms of presentation in the online environment (e.g. podcasts), the use of digital tools and information digital curation.
- Building library collections and information databases taking into account different areas of national culture.

- Building a network of contacts that can contribute to professional growth study stays and exchange internships, gaining experience from abroad.
- Public relations and advertising of the library at minimum cost ideas, innovations of young colleagues.
